A website has been developed for the PLASTICHEAL project to serve as the main dissemination platform for interested stakeholders.

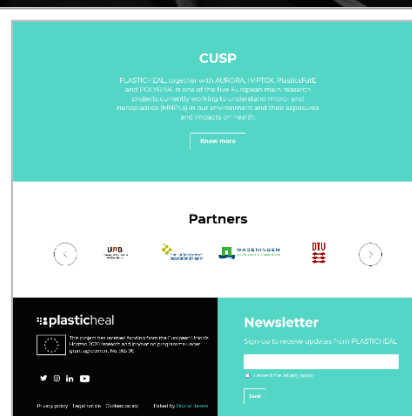
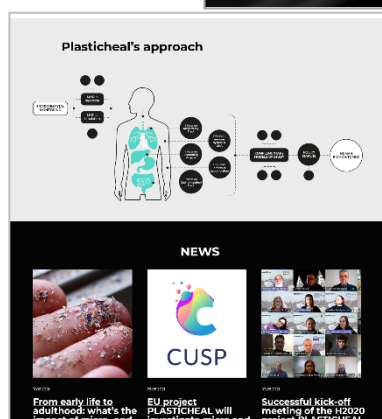
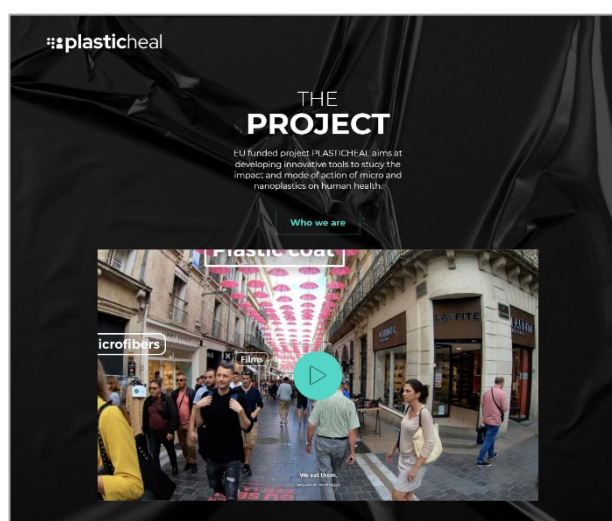
The overall objective is to create a modern and user-friendly website, designed using the project's visual identity, to be used as the primary online communication channel and interface towards different target audiences.

Figures 1-3. Screen captures of webpage - Home



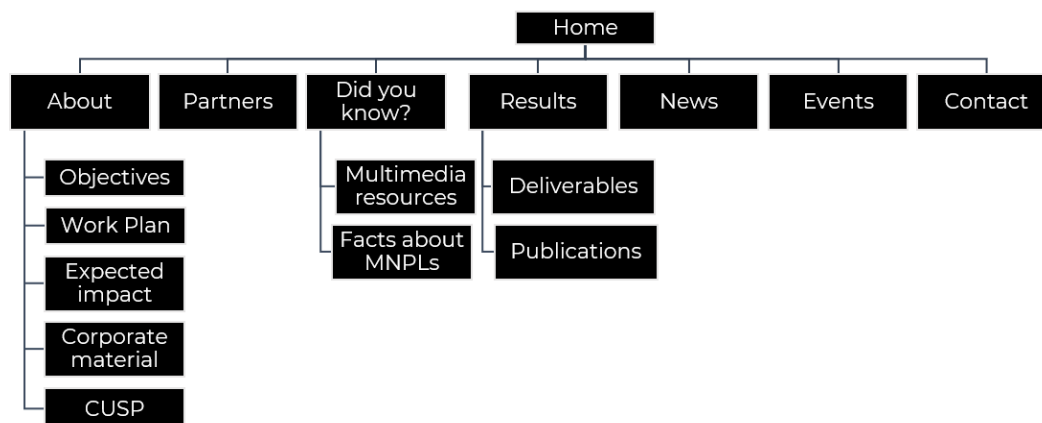


Figure 4. Website map.
